Ribbon Cutting for the Forest Avenue Substation Project

On October 18, 2025, State Rep Kate Hogan joined Justin Connell GM of Hudson Light & Power, as well as Chairman of the Board Justin Provencher and Board Member Joseph Fiorello for a ribbon cutting ceremony for the Forest Ave Substation Project.

Hudson Light & Power has announced the completion of its Forest Avenue Substation upgrade project strengthening the resiliency of the region's electric transmission system against extreme weather while improving the overall reliability and capacity of the electric grid. Locally, the completion of this project increases the overall capacity and resiliency to better serve the ratepayers of Hudson Light and Power well into the future.
